Club Chartered Boats

One of the key aims of the club is to arrange dive trips for the members. To that end, where club finances permit, the club is prepared to underwrite the charter of dive boats. However every dive trip should aim to be self-financed by those members planning to undertake the trip.

Where the committee agree that the club should charter a boat on behalf of the members the following provisions will apply:

1. At the time the decision to charter the boat is made the committee will determine the per diver cost, the likelihood the boat will be filled and potential financial risk to the club.
2. The committee will arrange for any deposit to be paid and those members who have signed up for the charter will reimburse the club before that payment is made or as soon as possible thereafter.
3. In the event that a member needs to withdraw from the charter they are expected to find a replacement. The club may assist in this but in the event no replacement can be found the member will remain liable for the deposit.
4. In the event that there is a shortage of divers to meet the full cost of the charter the club will meet the charter fee shortfall.
5. In the event that the charter is cancelled without loss of deposit any monies paid by a members in respect of the charter will be refunded to the member or at the direction of the member allocated towards the cost of another club charter.
6. In the event that the committee decide that the cost of meeting the charter fee greatly exceeds the loss of the deposit they may decide to cancel the charter. Any amount of deposit lost by members registered for the charter and who have not withdrawn from the charter will have their paid deposits refunded at the clubs expense.
7. Under no circumstances will the club reimburse any of the following type of expense:
 1. Accommodation cost
 2. Travel cost
 3. Loss of or hire of dive equipment
 4. any cost not directly related to the charter of a boat
 5. any cost not approved by the committee prior to the expense being incurred
8. Any decision must be made during a scheduled committee meeting to which all committee members have received advanced notice to attend.

Club Sponsorship

The club will sponsor club members to attend training courses where the course may result in an award which will benefit the overall club membership.

Such sponsorship maybe a contribution towards or the full amount of the course fees. Such sponsorship covers only the course fee and no provision is made towards the cost of any travelling or accommodation etc. The SAA courses currently eligible are;

1. Club Instructor
2. Rescue Diver – Club Instructors wanting to advance to Open Water Instructor
3. O2/EDFA – Club Instructors wanting to advance to Open Water Instructor
4. Open Water Instructor

The committee may stipulate conditions attached to the sponsorship, such as the member will be expected to take an active part in club training for a given period or that sponsorship will be paid post course in instalments.
